Brenda Bierman is scheduled to have a CT scan on 5/10 after her doctor had some concerns at a recent check-up.

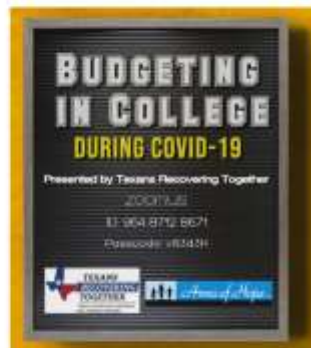
