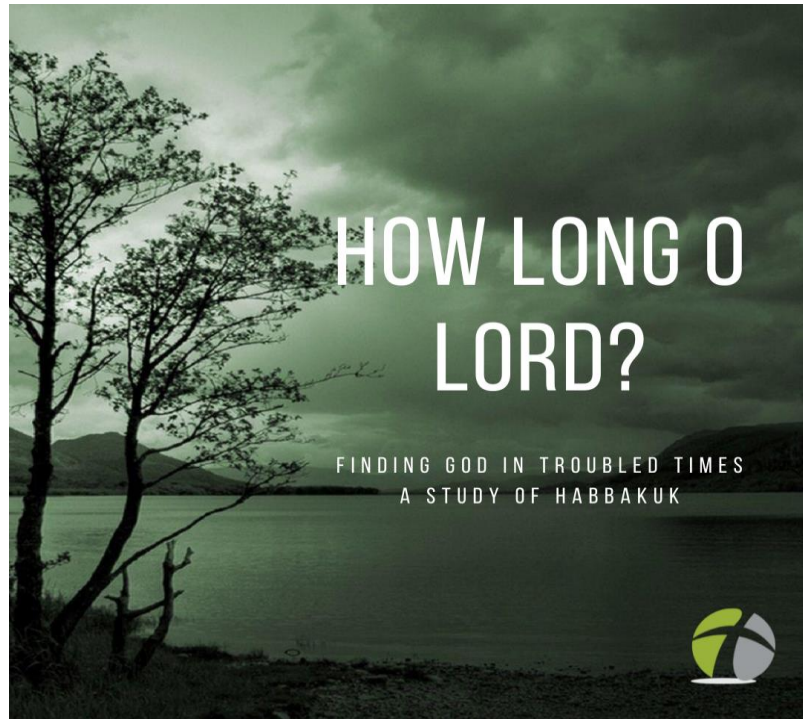

Weston Spencer RSV treatment was successful. However, he continued to need breathing assistance last week. An ENT doctor scoped his upper nasal airways and cleared him.
